Scripture passage(s):

¹I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come from? ²My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.

Why this is my favorite scripture:

When the psalmist wrote the first verse he was looking at the hills that surrounded the city of Jerusalem. All along those hills were altars set up to false gods. So he asks the question: *Where does my help come from?* Does it come from those false gods, those idols that can neither hear, see, speak or think? Of course not! My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.
